Novice classes

Entry Fee £15.00, £22.50 after the closing date or on the day – Prizes 1st £15 2nd £10 3rd £8

Amateur & Non-Qualifying classes

RIHS QUALIFYING CLASSES. Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15yrs of age or older. Classes 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 11, 12 are qualifiers for RIHS. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if first and second are already qualified then third place will go forward.

Horses competing in the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack and Riding Horse classes at the same show. This does not apply to SHB(GB) Ridden Sport Horse Classes.

The three highest placed prizewinners in all Open classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show September 2012.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each open class and a Championship rosette for each section.

DAY TICKETS

Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into a Novice, Amateur, Young Rider, Home Produced, Working and Open Affiliated classes only but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form from the BSHA Website.

Class 1 Novice Cob

Judges: Mr. P Hilton©Mr. P Cook®

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms, to be ridden. Not to have won a 1st prize of £25 or more, or a total of £100 or more in any showing class.

Class 2 RIHS Lightweight Cob

Judges: Mr. P Hilton©Mr. P Cook®

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, capable of carrying up to 14stone. To be ridden.

Class 3 RIHS Heavyweight Cob

Judges: Mr. P Hilton©Mr. P Cook®

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 155cm, capable of carrying more than 14stone. To be ridden.

Class 4 Amateur Owner/ Rider Cob

Judges: Mr. P Hilton©Mr. P Cook®

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cms. **To be ridden by an amateur as defined in rule 7 of the BSHA Rule Book 2012.**

Class 5 RIHS Maxi Cob

Judges: Mr. P Hilton©Mr. P Cook®

Open to Cobs exceeding 155cms – to be judged as Cobs. Judges must pay particular attention to type (ie short legged animals of Cob type). To be shown hogged. **Kindly Sponsored by Mr Jacobs.**

Class 6 Novice Hack

Judge: Mrs. B Ensten®©

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 160cms, Not to have won a 1st prize of £25 or more, or a total of £100 or more in any showing class.

Class 7 RIHS Small Hack Qualifier

Judge: Mrs. B Ensten®©

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 154cms.

Class 8 RIHS Large Hack Qualifier

Judge: Mrs. B Ensten®©

Mare or gelding 4 years or over exceeding 154cms and not exceeding 160cms.

Class 9 Amateur Owner / Rider Hack

Judge: Mrs. B Ensten®©

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 160cms. **To be ridden by an amateur as per rule 7 of the 2012 BSHA Rule Book.**

Hack Championship Open to 1st and 2nd prizewinners in classes 6,7, 8, and 9.

Not Before 2.30pm.

Class 10 Novice Riding Horse

Judge: Mr. John Poole®©

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms. Not to have won a 1st prize of £25 or more or a total of £100 or more in any showing class.

Class 11 Small Riding Horse Qualifier for RIHS

Judge: Mr. John Poole®©

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms.

Class 12 Large Riding Horse Qualifier for RIHS

Judge: Mr. John Poole®©

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 158cms.

Class 13 Amateur / Owner / Rider

Judge: Mr. John Poole®©

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms

Open to Riding Horses that are owned by an amateur. **To be ridden by an amateur. As per rule 7 in the BSHA Rule book 2012.**

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms, not to have won a total of £200 or 25 BE points or £200 BSJA. **Fences max. 2ft 9"**

Class 15 Intermediate Working Hunter

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms. **Fences max. 3ft**

Class 16 Open Working Hunter

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms. **Fences max 3ft 3"**

Class 17 The Retrained Racehorse Challenge

Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over and of any height. Riders must be 15 years old or over. Horses should be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. The first three qualify for the final at Royal Windsor Show 2013. All entries **MUST** be registered with Weatherbys in their General Stud Book and with RoR. The class is open to thoroughbreds that **HAVE** raced only. There will be a prize for the highest placed veteran 15years or over. The class will be run under the rules of RoR. Horses **NOT** to be ridden by the judge. Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

The class to be judged 40% jumping a mixture of 8 rustic/coloured fences. 20% Style while jumping and performance. 20% awarded for individual show and 20% conformation and suitability to be retrained. **Racing injuries will be overlooked.** For further details visit the RoR website www.ror.org.uk

Class 18 & 19 Judges: Mr. P Hilton©Mr. P Cook®

This class is a qualifier for The Global Foods Working Show Horse of the Year Final, to be held at the BSHA National Championship Show. The two highest placed horses in the top five, not already qualified, in each Open Working Show Horse class, will qualify for the final; no Horse placed lower than fifth will qualify. Those Shows held after the 2012 National Championship Show will carry the qualification(s) forward to 2013.

Entries can be made on a BSHA Day Ticket but to qualify for the final; Horse, Owner and Rider must be registered with the Association within fourteen days of qualification. Failure to register or notify the BSHA office of a date of a JMB measurement appointment, if required, will mean the qualification automatically passes down the line.

148cms. Not to have won a first prize £25 or more or more than a total of £100 in a Working Class. **Fences min 2ft3 max 2ft6 max 2ft6 spread. Day Tickets may be purchased by Non-Members.**

Class 19 Open Working Show Horse

Open to Hacks, Cobs/Maxi and Riding Horses. Mare or gelding 4 years or over exceeding 148cms. **Fences min 2'6" max 2ft9 max 2ft9 spread. Day Tickets may be purchased by Non-Members.**

Working Show Horse Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prizewinners in classes 18 & 19

The Tattersalls, RoR Thoroughbred Show Series 2012

Class 20. The Tattersalls and RoR Thoroughbred Ridden Show Horse Class

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4yo or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle. Horses should be plaited. The first two go forward to the championship at the Hickstead Derby Meeting on 24th June 2012. Qualification will go down to 4th place if the first 2 have already qualified. All entries **MUST** be registered with Weatherbys in their General Stud Book and **MUST** also be registered with the RoR. The class is open to thoroughbreds that have **RACED**. There will be a prize for the highest placed veteran 15years or over. The class will be run under the rules of RoR. Horses to be ridden by the judge. **Please be aware that the show will split the class on the horses last run in a race (NH or Flat) should the entries exceed 20. Please mark your entry form accordingly.** Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

Mare or Gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms. Not to have won a first prize of £50 or more or a total of £200 in any ridden hunter class before 1st January in the current year.

Mare or gelding. 4 years or over exceeding 148cms, capable of carrying up to 13st 7 lbs.

Class 23. Heavyweight Hunter.

Mare or gelding 4 years or over exceeding 148cms, capable of carrying more than 13st 7lbs

Class 24. Small Hunter

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms, but not exceeding 158cms.
